

1 mittee on Elective Franchise, and the Report of the
2 Committee on Convention Procedures, and that we will
3 perhaps be able also to take up the Committee on Judiciary,
4 If not, that would move ahead tomorrow morning.

5 I think we can complete our consideration of
6 all Reports if we adhere to the rules of debate, which
7 were adopted at the suggestion of one of the Commission
8 Members, or several of them last meeting, and which I
9 circulated to you.

10 May I suggest to you that while we will follow
11 the same rule as to reconsiderations that we have hereto-
12 fore followed, we are too far along to be reconsidering
13 any matters heretofore acted upon, unless they are of
14 really vital importance, and as heretofore, a Committee
15 desiring reconsideration will be permitted to do so if the
16 motion is approved by the Commission and on motion of a
17 Member, approved by the Commission we can reconsider.
18 Each of these will be necessarily without debate.

19 The rules of debate on motions are not intended
20 to apply to questions, and therefore we will follow our
21 usual procedure in the presentation of the Report. The
