mittee on Elective Franchise, and the Report of the
Committee on Convention Procedures, and that we will
perhaps be able also to take up the Committee on Judiciary
If not, that would move ahead tomorrow morning.

I think we can complete our consideration of all Reports if we adhere to the rules of debate, which were adopted at the suggestion of one of the Commission Members, or several of them last meeting, and which I circulated to you.

May I suggest to you that while we will follow the same rule as to reconsiderations that we have heretofore followed, we are too far along to be reconsidering any matters heretofore acted upon, unless they are of really vital importance, and as heretofore, a Committee desiring reconsideration will be permitted to do so if the motion is approved by the Commission and on motion of a Member, approved by the Commission we can reconsider. Each of these will be necessarily without debate.

The rules of debate on motions are not intended to apply to questions, and therefore we will follow our usual procedure in the presentation of the Report. The
