MR. RUSSELL: Yes. We meet again tomorrow night. Section 5. Elections. The General Assembly shall by law determine Legislative Districts, define residence, establish a system of permanent registration of voters, provide for the nomination of candidates, regulate the time, place, and manner of elections, provide for the administration of elections and for absentee voting, insure secrecy of voting and protect the integrity of the election process.

This section reflects again a mandate of the Commission at its May 16 meeting where we attempted to shorten the entire article by delegating to the Legislature the entire administration of elections, including absentee voting.
