THE CHAIRMAN: I think probably we can take them up one at a time initially, don't you, Mr. Case?

MR. CASE: It makes no difference to me.

THE CHAIRMAN: Is there any comment, then, or question on Subsection 1? If not, proceed to Subsection 2.

MR. CASE: Subsection 2 says, On the third Wednesday in January in each year (except in the case of a newly-elected Governor, and then not later than ten days after the convening of the General Assembly), unless such time be extended by the General Assembly, the Governor, shall submit to the General Assembly a budget for the next ensuing fiscal year.

This is the same as the current provision, which was an amendment effected only two years ago to dovetail the introduction of the budget to the General Assembly, in conformity with the requirement for 70-day sessions.

Such budget shall contain a complete and balanced plan, by programs, of proposed expenditures and shall also contain estimated revenues for said fiscal
