1 cerned, the only thing really that was mandatory was a 2 showing of the estimated surplus or deficits of revenue. 3 We felt that this should be a constitutional requirement. 4 Other than that, we felt that the form, the information 5 contained in the budget, et cetera, should be as required 6 by law. 7 Any questions? Are there any THE CHAIRMAN: 8 comments? 9 I have a question or a matter I would like you 10 to comment on, Mr. Case. Your Report makes mention of 11 the fact that you have added in here a requirement, not in 12 the present Constitution, that the budget shall contain 13 a complete and balanced/ by programs. I take it, then, 14 that it would be impossible under this provision to have 15 a budget provide for a deficit? 16 MR. CASE: That is correct. 17 THE CHAIRMAN: And this Section taken in 18 conjunction with Section 4, I think, and the other Sec-. 19 tions, would make it impossible for a budget bill to 20 provide for deficit financing.

MR. CASE:

That is correct.
