don't know. It was such a fundamental thing to us that we didn't make any research on it.

MR. SCANLAN: I am not disputing this might be good thing. I just wanted to get some picture of what the situation is in the country generally.

MR. CASE: I think when it started, it was unique, and it probably has been copied.

MR. SCANLAN: I have some vague feeling that Virginia has provisions something like this, and at times when it was criticized, that it has resulted in failure in recent days to appropriate sufficient money for schools and mental health, that sort of thing. If you don't know, you don't know.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Gentry?

MR. GENTRY: Over recent years there has been considerable criticism of the great inaccuracies of the Controller in estimating surplus. Is this the same estimate you are calling for here?

MR. CASE: Yes, Mr. Gentry. The criticism has been with the people, the method by which the estimates have been made by, not by the fact that an estimate
