1 should be made. We got considerable static on that 2 point in hearings before our Committee, but estimates 3 can be as good as they can be bad, depending on who makes them, and the methodology they use. 5 THE CHAIRMAN: The estimates are not made 6 just by the Comptroller, but by a Board of Estimates, are 7 they not? 8 MR. CASE: They are today. It is an executive 9 function. 10 THE CHAIRMAN: That is something created by 11 statute? 12 That is right. MR. CASE: 13 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further questions or com-14 ments? 15 Mr. Haile? 16 MR. HAILE: Mr. Chairman, a question: 17 section 2 says that such budget shall contain a complete 18 plan of proposed expenditures. The question is, does 19 that include expenditures for capital projects? 20 MR. CASE: It does not.
