1 Department of Education discuss with the Budget Director 2 their findings. Our Committee found that there was a genuine give and take between the two, but once a judg-3 ment is made as to what the budget shall be and it is 4 fixed, then that is it, and when that budget gets to the 5 6 Governor, by constitutional mandate, he cannot change it. 7 It must go in that amount, and in that form to the B General Assembly. This is not to say that the Governor 9 has no control over any part of the budget for the State Fublic School System. He does. He has complete authority 10 11 over all things that you might term administrative, such 12 as Dr. Sensenbaugh's salary or the salary of his secre-13 tary, or the people in the head office. There are many 14 other things that the State Department of Education does which are programs outside of actually instructing 15 16 students in the local school systems, and all of these' 17 programs are subject to revision, just like any other 18 department's progrems are subject to revision by the 19 Governor, but with respect to teaching in the public 20 schools, there is no chance, there is no availability 21 or room for the Governor to move.
