phrase, State support to local school systems as required by law, would not embrace State support of higher education?

MR. CASE: It does not.

THE CHAIRMAN: But I would take it that under the provisions of Section 2, I guess it is, if the Legislature passed a law providing for a certain program of aid to higher education, then under Subsection 2 the Governor would have to include provision to finance that program in his budget under the next to last sentence of Section 2?

MR. CASE: He would have to put in the program. The Governor wouldhave to put in the program. The Legislature can't think up a program and pass it by themselves, unless by supplemental appropriation act, and then they have to finance the money for it. We come to that later.

THE CHAIRMAN: I don't mean that. I mean for instance in 1965, the Legislature passed a bill providing a certain program for aid to higher education, just as it has for aid to local school systems. Then in preparing the budget for 1967-68, under Subsection 2, the Governor
