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MR. CASE: I don't want to get into a decision not or discussion about what is and what is/higher education, but 1 will agree with you that junior colleges are included.

THE CHAIRIAN: Any further question or comment?

MR. CLAGETT: Mr. Chairman, do you understand, then, that if the General Assembly made an appropriation for higher education and it then was passed on as part of the budget, that it would be protected from any revision by the Governor? Is that under Section 3?

MR. CASE: No. Subsection 3 does not apply.

MR. CLAGETT: That is the way I would read it, so it would be subject to revision by the Governor in the budget.

MR. CASE: Well, except this: That if the law, and Mr. Eney asked me this question, suppose the Legislature passes a law authorizing and directing the Governor to pay to each institution of higher education \$40 times the number of students enrolled in that institution as of the first of September, the Governor has to follow the law.
