

1 He can't just ignore it. I think he would go to jail if  
2 he did.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Does that answer your question,  
4 Mr. Claggett?

5 MR. GLAGETT: I believe it does.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Scanlan?

7 MR. SCANLAN: Just one more question, Dick. In  
8 your Report you mention the fact that experience shows  
9 that the funds appropriated for education that have a  
10 high degree of reverter, overestimates, is it possible that  
11 the presence of the predecessor language, the guarantee  
12 that the budget can't be reduced for the public school  
13 system, is it possible that this provision of the present  
14 Constitution was a contributory factor toward this ten-  
15 dency to overappropriate or overestimate public school  
16 funds?

17 MR. CASE: I don't think so. The reason for  
18 the high reversion lies in the simple fact that the Board  
19 of Education feels that it can always turn the money back  
20 if it has got an excess, but it can't educate a youngster  
21 if it doesn't have enough money to do it, if it runs out
