shall be deemed to deny the political subdivisions the power to prescribe additional qualifications of voters offering to vote in local elections.

THE CHAIRMAN: This could be broadened to cover the matter of registration, absentee voting, et cetera.

palatable fashion. I don't like this language for pure palatability but if it says nothing in this article would be deemed to deny political subdivisions power to govern local elections under home rule provisions or some such thing as that --

THE CHAIRMAN: Or go ahead and provide the things we say the Legislature should provide in Section 5.

DR. BURDETTE: Exactly.

MR. CLAGETT: I am beginning to have doubts about whether or not after the Legislature gets through making its prescriptions and then you come along and say that political subdivisions may make additional ones whether you haven't already put a floor under them.
