

1 THE CHAIRMAN: That is part of the problem.

2 I don't know that that meets Mr. Haile's point.

3 DR. JENKINS: The law does not provide it.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: It might. Let's take a ten-  
5 minute break.

6 (At this time a short recess was taken.)

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Case, do you want to reply  
8 further to Mr. Haile's question?

9 MR. CASE: Mr. Haile asked whether or not this  
10 was intended to apply to purely public schools or would  
11 private schools come within the ambit of the language?  
12 I answered that it was intended, certainly as always to  
13 have been used as a vehicle for financing public schools  
14 only. However, and I must confess that for that reason,  
15 our Committee did not consider the necessity for inserting  
16 the word, public, between the words, local and school.  
17 Since our recess, it has occurred to me that probably the  
18 language as it is stated is the preferable form because  
19 there may indeed -- assuming now it has only applied to  
20 public schools in the past -- there may indeed come a  
21 time when aid to private schools will be sanctioned by the
