

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Just a moment. Is the motion
2 seconded?

3 MR. SAYRE: Seconded.

4 MR. SYKES: In the existing Constitution,
5 under Section 11, the language says, and for the public
6 schools, as provided by law. Now, if we are going to
7 in effect carry forward and tidy up the present system,
8 which has worked quite well, I see no reason for working
9 any far-reaching changes and making an unjustifiable
10 limitation on the Governor's power, which goes far beyond
11 anything that has existed heretofore. I feel right strong-
12 ly about the point.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

14 Mr. Sayre?

15 MR. SAYRE: If Mr. Sykes' interpretation is
16 correct, and I understand Mr. Case did not contradict him,
17 in the use of the word, public, here, it would seem to
18 me that the question is whether we want to, in effect,
19 find as to public schools without disallowing additional
20 consideration for private schools. Therefore, I think it
21 would be probably good policy to insert the word, public,
