2 MR. CASE: I just told Mr. Sachs I didn't think
3 it was too much. The word, local, is the word generally
4 used to define a public school system. In all candor, I
5 must answer it that way.

6 MR. CLAGETT: You would distinguish it from
7 church, private or any other designation?

8 MR. CASE: I don't distinguish it. I say that
9 it is the word that is most often applied to the schools
10 that are maintained in the Counties and Baltimore City,
11 by the Counties and by Baltimore City.

12 MR. CLAGETT: I would agree it is a word of
13 art.

14 DR. BURDETTE: May I ask a question? I would
15 like to get the Chair's clarification of this if possible.
16 Are we voting on whether schools should be public, as
17 against the possibility of allowing public or private,
18 or are we only voting about the power of the Governor to
19 supervise the budget?

20 THE CHAIRMAN: The latter.
