4 Mr. Gentry, you have already spoken.

6 MR. SCANLAN: I have the gravest reservations
7 about raising the local public school systems of the
8 State to the co-equal status from the point of budgetary
9 equality with the Judiciary and Legislature, but I
10 defer to the judgment of the Committee on that point. If
11 we are going to do that, for heaven's sake, let's keep
12 it as far on a category as possible by adopting the
13 amendment using the word, public, to precede the word,
14 school.
