system in Maryland which also has local schools under independent school systems, as there is parochial school systems with local school systems. I think of local as contrasted to the word, State, rather than as synonymous with the word, public. THE CHAIRMAN: I would think that Mr. Case is right to this extent, at least, that when you use all three words, local school systems, in present day connotation, that this would almost certainly mean a public school, but I think he is also correct that it is entirely possible that in the future, the local subdivision would adopt a system embracing both public and private schools, in which event I think his second comment would be correct, that local school system might then embrace the private system. MRS. BOTHE: Mr. Chairman? THE CHAIRMAN: You have already spoken.

I wasn't going to speak. MRS, BOTHE: going to propose.
