

1 MR. MILLER: I think it has all been talked
2 about. I just want it on the record.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? Are
4 you ready for the question?

5 MR. SAYRE: Could Mr. Miller speak about ten
6 seconds longer on this? It is from the bottom line --

7 THE CHAIRMAN: His motion is to strike the
8 phrase, beginning in the fifth line of Section 3, and
9 for State support to public local school systems, as re-
10 quired by law. Any further question? Is there any fur-

14 further question on Subsection 3? If not, we move to
