intends? I can see so far as revenues in the budget that the Legislature should probably not be allowed to increase them at least. I don't know that it makes that much difference whether it decreases them, but in any case, it is acting directly on the revenue estimates. I don't know enough about budgeting to know whether some other things that the Legislature might be doing might be said to affect the revenue estimates.

MR. CASE: You get into words and semantics here. That word is now found in Subsection 6 of --

MR. SYKES: Not in connection with the new thing you have added. My question is, how this integrates with the existing language.

MR. CASE: I thought it did.

THE CHAIRMAN: I had the same question, not as to A but as to C, and I wondered if you could accomplish everything you wanted by using the word, change, instead of affect.

MR. CASE: Actually as far as C is concerned, that is a direct takeoff from present Subsection 6, which uses the word, affect, and uses the word, public schools.
