moment that a County appropriated, or made provision for appropriation for private schools and persuaded the Governor to include that in the budget bill, and then the Legislature wanted to regulate that amount or to prohibit it, it would not be able to do so, would it? MR. CASE: In the first place, a County can't put anything in the Governor's budget by local appropriation. MR. CLAGETT: I realize that, but assuming that they persuaded the Governor to include it. Then they would get away from the effect or any effect that the Assembly could exercise over them. No. I don't follow the question. MR. CASE: THE CHAIRMAN: I would think, Mr. Clagett, that the phrase, laws of the State, means laws passed by the Legislature and not local laws passed by a political

subdivision. In other words, as I understand Paragraph C, the restriction on the Legislature there is to tie its hands only to the extent that it has already tied its own MR. CASE: I might also say, Mr. Chairman, that
