2 clause in Section 3. I mean it refers to the same thing.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Further questions?

4 Mr. Haile?

5 MR. HAILE: For the record, answering the ques-
6 tion of Mr. Scanlan of whether this provision appears in
7 any other State Constitutions, it does appear in the
8 Charter of the Baltimore County Government, and it has been
9 our experience that it is a very helpful provision.

10 Mr. Donoho worked on that, and I believe he advised this
11 Committee. He finds it very satisfactory and very useful.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Any other questions? Proceed
13 with the consideration of this Section. Hold your motion
14 until we conclude consideration of the Section, Mr. Sykes.

15 MR. CASE: The next sentence says, The General
16 Assembly may amend the bill, the budget bill, of course,
17 by increasing or decreasing the items therein relating
18 to the General Assembly.

19 That is a verbatim of the present constitution-
20 al provision. It may increase the items there in relating
21 to the Judiciary. The same thing is true.
