MR. HAILE: This means items of the program then, of the nature of a program, lump sum, yes.

MR. CASE: Yes.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe?

MRS. BOTHE: I am somewhat confused as to how the General Assembly might increase the revenue estimates. There is no bill before them, I gather, and it is an executive function to make the estimate. I don't understand by what procedure the General Assembly does this.
