2 simply say compensation?

3 MR. CASE: It is just taken from the existing
4 compensation.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: I know it is.

6 MR. CASE: All right, compensation, remunera-
7 tion.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Can we take out the word,
9 salary, or? Any objection, take out salary, or.

10 Now, in the second or third and fourth lines,
11 you refer to the principle of all indebtedness created
12 on behalf of the State as required by Section 34. In
13 view of the fact that in that Section, which will have a
14 different number eventually, you provide specifically that
15 only what applies with that Section can constitute a
16 State debt, can we use simply the term, debt, here,
17 State debt, instead of the cross reference?

18 MR. CASE: Indebtedness was used to refer to
19 State debt, as used in that Section, as a word of art.

20 THE CHAIRMAN: I just wondered whether we could
21 avoid the cross reference, which is just one of the things
