1 MR. SAYRE: The word uniform would be fine, wouldn't it? 3 THE CHAIRMAN: That wasn't the question. 4 you will look at Section 5, it was suggested and the 5 Committee accepted the addition of the word uniform 6 before system in the third line, leaving aside for the question of whether this would have the effect of making 8 it applicable to municipal elections. Do you have any 9 objection to the use of the word uniform still thinking 10 of it as state and national election? 11. PROFESSOR ASPER: No, 1 think anything done 12 on a state-wide basis setting up election procedure 13 would be okay. 14 MR. SAYRE: I think it isn't true necessarily 15 that the word uniform makes it constitutionally necessary. 16 THE CHAIRMAN: Makes what constitutionally

necessary?

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MR. SAYRE: To have the state or congress manage the same way in all counties and subdivisions.

MR. CLAGETT: In other words, the act could
