

1 MR. CASE: This, of course, was written before
2 the Commission conceived, or before the Commission made
3 that judgment. It would be my feeling that it would be
4 ten days from the regular session and not ten days -- I
5 mean, from the original session and not the extended
6 period.

7 MR. SAYRE: Shouldn't that be spelled out,
8 then?

9 MR. CASE: I don't know.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Couldn't you accomplish it by
11 simply saying 50 days, that if the bill shall not have
12 been finally acted on by the General Assembly within 50
13 days after its introduction?

14 MR. CASE: You could.

15 the chairman: Would that be acceptable? That
16 would mean ten days before the end of the session, if
17 the Legislature extended.

18 MR. CASE: You could do it.

19 MR. GENTRY: What is the figure, 50 or 60?

20 THE CHAIRMAN: If the bill is not finally
