

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Before the Committee on the
2 Executive Department.

3 MRS. BOTHE: I gather there was no objection.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: I think the Liaison Committee
5 that appeared, by and large they were all in sympathy
6 with it. The only, as I recall the testimony, the only
7 departure from their views from that of the Committee
8 was the feeling that the Legislature ought to be able to
9 consider other appropriation bills, but not finally act
10 on them.

11 MR. CASE: That is right.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: That, I think, was the only point
13 on which they differed. Any further questions? I think
14 Mr. Haile had a question, and I passed him by.

15 MR. HAILLE: The provision that the budget will
16 become law if not passed by the Legislature is in our
17 County Charter. It works excellently, excellent provision.
18 We don't have the delays for instance that Baltimore
19 City has, and the embarrassment as a result of it.
