2 control over using his people so that he can get the job
3 of government done in the event that the Legislature wanted
4 to constantly have someone testifying before it. Suppose
5 that the Comptroller was asked to testify every day of
6 the session and that Comptroller is needed in the Executive
7 Department? Just suppose that. How would you prevent
8 that under this Article?

9 MR. CASE: I don't suppose you would.

10 MR. SAYRE: Don't you think you ought to have
11 some provision?

12 MR. CASE: I don't know how you can limit it
13 and make it meaningful.

14 MR. SAYRE: I think that is the problem,
15 Therefore which is the worse evil?

16 THE CHAIRMAN: I take it that the Committee
17 feels that it would be a worse evil not to have the Legis-
18 lature have the right to require the personnel to appear.
19 Otherwise, they wouldn't have recommended this.

20 MRS. BOTHE: This is not departure from present
21 constitutional law, as I understand Section 7. The
