

1 Legislature now has the power to request.

2 MR. CASE: That is right.

3 MRS. BOTHE: This capsulizes.

4 MR. CASE: Combines three Sections into one,  
5 that is all it does, and leaves the Governor out as a  
6 person who can be required to appear.

7 MRS. BOTHE: Has the Governor ever been required  
8 to appear against his wishes?

9 MR. CASE: Not to my knowledge.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Burdette?

11 DR. BURDETTE: I think it does something else.  
12 I believe I am for it. It seems to me that the old  
13 Constitution gives not only to the Governor, but major  
14 department heads, the right to<sup>go to</sup> the Legislature. The Com-  
15 mittee's draft does not give those department heads the  
16 right, save as they are designated by the Governor.

17 I think that may be a good thing, but I presume  
18 that has been considered by the Committee.

19 MR. CASE: That is correct. That was considered  
20 and written to cover that point.
