JUDGE ADKINS: They have a pretty strong sanction if they fail to appear. They simply don't pass that item in the budget. That is pretty apt to make a department head appear when requested.

MR. SAYRE: I have reservations on this. would like to move that some form of limitation on the scope of this legislative power be considered and that it be submitted back to the Committee for redrafting.
