Subsection 7 and retain the last clause. A vote in favor 1 of this motion is not a vote in favor of making that 2 change in Subsection 7. Is that clear to everyone? All 3 those in favor of the amendment, please signify by a show 4 5 of hands. 6 MR. BROOKS: Eleven. 7 THE CHAIRMAN: Contrary? MR. BROOKS: Six. 8 THE CHAIRMAN: The motion is carried, 11 to 6. 9 The question now arises on the amended motion. Are you 10 11 ready for the question? DR. BURDETTE: Is the amended motion including 12 the modifying language that Mr. Case is willing to accept 13 or not? I myself hope so. I will vote for it in 14 either case. What are we voting for? 15 THE CHAIRMAN: I take it the modifying language 16 would not now be pertinent, because that pertained to the 17 first part that has been eliminated as I understood it. 18 DR.
