1 motion to eliminate. 2 I meant in the motion to DR. BURDETTE: 3 eliminate, and making the motion that we eliminate only the 4 first part. Now, I want to vote against eliminating the 5 first part. 6 THE CHAIRMAN: I may have misunderstood the purpose of the added language. The motion to amend was to 7 8 eliminate the first clause of the Section so that the 9 motion now would be that Section 7, instead of reading 10 as it does now, would in substance say merely that the 11 Governor, or any such person as he shall designate, shall 12 have the right to appear for the purpose of explaining 13 the budget bill or any item therein contained. 14 DR. BURDETTE: No. 15 THE CHAIRMAN: It was my understanding that the 16 language suggested by Mr. Case would have pertained to 17 the first clause, eliminated clause. 18 That is right. MR. CASE: 19 DR. BURDETTE: My understanding of the parlia-20 mentary situation was we had a motion to eliminate the

whole of Section 7.
