

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sykes has the floor.

2 MR. SYKES: I waive any debate.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sayre?

4 MR. SAYRE: I would like to ask Mr. Sykes if he  
5 would allow an amendment to that, which I would insert,  
6 any person other than the Governor?

7 MR. SYKES: Yes, I would accept that.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Then, I take it that the, other  
9 than the Governor, would come after the phrase, monies,  
10 that has just been added, would it not?

11 MR. CLAGETT: After person, wouldn't it?

12 THE CHAIRMAN: I hardly think you would say,  
13 any person other than the Governor in any department,  
14 would you?

15 MR. SAYRE: I realize the problem.

16 MR. SYKES: In any person in any department,  
17 branch, bureau, or agency of the State Government, et  
18 cetera, then after the word, monies, you would put, other  
19 than the Governor in parentheses, I think.

20 MR. SAYRE: That is fine.

21 THE CHAIRMAN: You accept it, Mr. Sykes?
