

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Case, with respect to the
2 last question, is there any objection if the Committee
3 on Style deems it proper to eliminate that last sentence
4 from this Section and simply add into Subsection 7 the
5 phrase, supplementary appropriation bill?

6 MR. CASE: No, just so that the General Assem-
7 bly and the Governor and the Executive Department have
8 the same rights with respect to supplementary appropria-
9 tion bills as they have with respect to the budget bill.
