two to four years. Yet we might end up wanting to provide it for four years or might not. Would it be desirable to approve this tentatively but flag it when we have the other parts of the constitution assembled to recheck and see whether it makes sense then to leave this every two years? Is that acceptable?

MR. RUSSELL: Yes.

THE CHAIRMAN: With that understanding then the question is on the approval of Section 6. Those in favor indicate by aye. Contrary, no. Tentatively approved.

Section 7.

MR. RUSSELL: Elections in Political
Subdivisions. Nothing contained in this Article
shall be deemed to deny to political subdivisions the
power to prescribe additional qualifications for voters
offering to vote in local elections.

This was the subject matter of a great deal of discussion at the last Commission meeting and it is it really offered in the same form/originally was. I move its adoption. This is consistent with hopefully the
