3 THE CHAIRMAN: That one thing might be some-
4 thing that would involve a supplementary appropriation
5 bill.

6 MR. CASE: I don't follow you because if there
7 is no budget bill, there is nothing to supplement. There
8 is no budget bill. It goes down in a special session.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: I understand that. Suppose
10 you had an emergency arise and the Governor called a
11 special session of the Legislature. Wouldn't you neces-
12 sarily, if you were going to appropriate any money, have
13 to do it by supplemental appropriation bill?

14 MR. CASE: I don't know how you could supple-
15 ment something.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: I realise that, except as I
17 understood it in Subsection 8, any bill that provides
18 an appropriation and isn't the budget bill is by defini-
19 tion a supplementary appropriation bill.

20 MR. CASE: A supplemental appropriation bill is a
21 bill, is a money bill, which is supplementary to the
