this, that what this Section says, in effect, is that if you have a special session, these rules, 1 to 8, et seq, are applicable.

THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.

MR. CASE: That is what it really means.

THE CHAIRMAN: Suppose you had a good disaster and the Governor called a session of the Legislature to provide aid to the affected area, and they had to do it by money. Wouldn't this necessarily be by supplemental appropriation bill? There would be no budget before the Legislature.

MR. CASE: We are getting all tangled up in words. Let me read to you what 14 says, so that we can have it all before us: In the event of any inconsistency between any of the provisions of this Section, and any of the other provisions of the Constitution, the provisions of this Section shall prevail. Obviously, that is inappropriate for the Constitution.

Nothing herein shall in any manner affect the provisions of Section 34 of Article III of the Constitution. We don't need that. That is already taken care of,
