

1 this, that what this Section says, in effect, is that if
2 you have a special session, these rules, 1 to 8, et seq,
3 are applicable.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.

5 MR. CASE: That is what it really means.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Suppose you had a good disaster
7 and the Governor called a session of the Legislature
8 to provide aid to the affected area, and they had to do
9 it by money. Wouldn't this necessarily be by supplemental
10 appropriation bill? There would be no budget before the
11 Legislature.

12 MR. CASE: We are getting all tangled up in
13 words. Let me read to you what 14 says, so that we can
14 have it all before us: In the event of any inconsistency
15 between any of the provisions of this Section, and any of
16 the other provisions of the Constitution, the provisions
17 of this Section shall prevail. Obviously, that is in-
18 appropriate for the Constitution.

19 Nothing herein shall in any manner affect the
20 provisions of Section 34 of Article III of the Constitu-
21 tion. We don't need that. That is already taken care of,
