3 ing the Governor from calling an extraordinary session  
4 of the General Assembly, or as preventing the General  
5 Assembly at such extraordinary session from considering  
6 any emergency appropriation or appropriations.

7 Now, Mr. Sachs wrote this Section. That is  
8 his contribution to this.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: If I may pursue this a moment,  
10 Mr. Case, because I think your next to last comment is  
11 the one that troubles me about this. The question I  
12 have in my mind is whether the use of the words here,  
13 emergency appropriation, or, the use of similar words  
14 in the present Constitution, connote the idea that the  
15 Legislature can make an appropriation out of the general  
16 Treasury other than by a budget bill or a supplementary  
17 appropriation bill, and I understood you to say --

18 MR. CASE: It is my feeling that they cannot.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Right. Therefore, since at  
20 this emergency session you would not have a budget, it
