16 question that was asked with respect to Section 2, that if
17 it is not provided for in the budget, it cannot come out
18 of the general Treasury; that it must be by a supple-
19 mentary appropriation bill, which must provide a tax,
20 which would mean to me that in a special session, to meet
21 an emergency, the Legislature would have to provide the
