a supplemental appropriation because you don't supplement anything. What you are talking about is the manner of making an emergency appropriation, and what I think we want to say is that the Legislature may consider an emergency appropriation at an extraordinary session, and it shall make it in the same manner as it makes the supplemental appropriation, or handles the supplemental appropriation bill in the regular session, but this raises an additional question, which hasn't yet been discussed. The extraordinary session can have before it a proposal by the Governor for funding, or a proposal made by the Legislature. The proposal made by the Governor is not a budget, but the question would arise as to whether or not the Legislature would have to dispose of the proposal by the Governor before it could handle the thing by itself, whether the same relationship should exist between the Governor's proposal and the Legislature's proposals, as exist between the budget and the supplemental appropriation bill. It seems to me that that would have to be thought through, but that what we are really talking about is the manner of making an extraordinary appropriation,
