

1 myriad of boards and agencies, such as the Hairdressers
2 Board, et cetera, have what they call special funds.
3 They are not called dedicated funds but they are special
4 funds which mean, in effect, that these agencies finance
5 themselves through the fees they collect.

6 This is a broad subject, and is one that
7 would require an intensive study. I have written to
8 Mr. Sayre in response to his request that our Committee
9 look into this and told him that certainly it couldn't
10 be done except on a prospective basis, because of the
11 argument or position I have just stated; I also told
12 him that our Committee has not or had not met and indeed,
13 has not met since I received his request in this area,
14 and therefore I haven't had a chance to put it up to
15 them. However, the Committee does have before it two
16 other subjects which the Committee, or perhaps before the
17 Committee which are perhaps more important than this, and
18 they are Article 15 of the Declaration of Rights, in which
19 I shall attempt to preserve some very old language and
20 some very modern concepts, and we will talk about that,
21 perhaps, at the next meeting, and all other provisions
