myriad of boards and agencies, such as the Hairdressers Board, et cetera, have what they call special funds. They are not called dedicated funds but they are special funds which mean, in effect, that these agencies finance themselves through the fees they collect.

This is a broad subject, and is one that would require an intensive study. I have written to Mr. Sayre in response to his request that our Committee look into this and told him that certainly it couldn't be done except on a prospective basis, because of the argument or position I have just stated; I also told him that our Committee has not or had not met and indeed, has not met since I received his request in this area, end therefore I haven't had a chance to put it up to them. However, the Committee does have before it two other subjects which the Committee, or perhaps before the Committee which are perhaps more important than this, and they are Article 15 of the Declaration of Rights, in which I shall attempt to preserve some very old language and some very modern concepts, and we will talk about that, perhaps, at the next meeting, and all other provisions
