2 MR. CASE: This is just a recital of fact.

3 MR. CLAGETT: I protest, too, because the
4 Political Subdivisions Subcommittee has recommended the
5 creation of authorities and the collection of a tax by
6 those authorities, and that was amended by Mr. Adkins
7 to provide that the authority could collect the tax
8 levied by the Legislature, by the General Assembly, and
9 it seems to me it fits in squarely with the problem that
10 Mr. Case is being asked to make a study of and included
11 in just his protest in having to do that.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment?

13 MR. CLAGETT: We don't feel qualified to do it.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sayre?

15 MR. SAYRE: If no deadline is set and we
16 simply ask for timely submission to this Commission of
17 material on that subject, that would satisfy me as long
18 as we get it before our attention. I am pleased with
19 the State of Maryland now, but I am worried about where
20 we might go if we don't have such a prohibition in regard
