is one passed by a three-fifth vote of all the members of each house of the General Assembly, it shall not take effect until thirty days after its approval by a majority of those voting on the question.

Previously we had had a situation where we provided that the law should be suspended and we provided also that the petition should be filed before the effective date.

It was pointed out that might be impractical because the Legislature can, of course, pass a law with an immediate effective date, that is, one which precedes June 1. In this fashion we completely revamped this and we feel it is actually better than previously submitted. We allowed a 60-day period for filing of a petition but, of course, the law would not be suspended during the interim. We don't feel that is a serious handicap to a referendum anyway. Only if it is rejected, the law, by a majority of those voting on the question, would it stand repealed. We have, however, allowed for a suspension if in fact the petition is filed prior to the effective date unless, of course, it
