THE CHAIRMAN: Any questions or comments?

MR. CASE: What is the substantive change

MR. GENTRY: The change is this. previously we had said that the petition had to be filed before the effective date. It was pointed out when this was submitted that that was very impractical because you could have a law passed with an immediate effective date which wouldn't allow for filing of a petition. Therefore, we went to this style which allows you a 60-dayperiod in which to file your petition. That would be the substantial change in this draft over this previously submitted. Plus the fact that in the other draft previously submitted we provided for suspension of the law during the referendum period until the vote was taken unless it was one of these passed by a three-fifths vote. Here we only allow for suspension if in fact the referendum is filed prior
