petition for referendum would not suspend the operation 1 2 of that law. 3 MRS. FREEDLANDER: That is correct. 4 MR. CLAGETT: That is what this says. 5 MR. CASE: It doesn't say that. I suppose you could imply it but it doesn't say it. 6 7 MR. BROOKS: Second paragraph. 8 DR. BURDETTE: 'Law shall stand repealed 30 days thereafter. 9 10 MR. CASE: If the petition is filed before the date on which the law is to take effect, unless the 11 12 law is passed -- yes. 13 MR. CLAGETT: It stands until it is 14 repealed. 15 MR. CASE: That is right, but suppose it is passed by three-fifths. It doesn't really say what 16 17 happens. 18 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Case's point is it does not affirmatively say. 19 20 MR. CASE: That is right, it does not say it.
