12 THE CHAIRMAN: When it has received final
13 approval to make it a law.

14 MR. CLAGETT: And not its effective date.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Either when signed by the
16 Governor or passed over his veto.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion of
