the Committee considers the language being proposed by the Subdivision Committee that Baltimore City be considered a county is applicable here also.

MR. GENTRY: Yes, we do.

THE CHAIRMAN: This isn't clear in any draft of the Constitution we now have because the provision actually, I think, is literally included only in the Article on the Judiciary but in discussing that the Commission decided for all purposes Baltimore City would be considered a county.

MR. MITCHELL: I would like to ask a question.

I am thinking in terms of the requirement that not more than one-half of such required number shall be voters residing in any one county. I am thinking of the possibility that the Legislature may make a classification of various counties by grouping them and perhaps have three counties with great differences in population. Would that still be proper in that case?

For example, suppose Prince Georges were tied in with St. Mary's and Charles on a classification. Would there be some adjustment on this referendum to
