from two of those counties, composing the three. No objection to that. It would have to equal the five per cent.

THE CHAIRMAN: Further discussion?

MR. GENTRY: Section 10. Restrictions.

No plan for legislative reapportionment or congressional redistricting, no law imposing a tax and no law making an appropriation for maintaining the state government or for aiding or maintaining any public institution shall be subject to referendum.

Only change is as shown.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any comment or question? Mr. Sayre?

MR. SAYRE: Question. When we talk about appropriation for maintaining the state government, et cetera, does this mean that you could alter something in this area other than appropriations? It seems to me we ought to have more restrictions than this because there is a standard prohibition pretty much against changing the judiciary.

MR. GENTRY: There were two areas which it
