was felt by the Commission should be withdrawn from referendum. Those two areas were the reapportionment area, both spheres, and also money matters. That was the intention and that's what is embodied here.

MR. MILLER: Nothing sacrosanct about the judiciary. If there were a pork barrel bill to make three times as many judges and the people didn't want it, it would be voted down.

asked you to pause before was I remembered having seen in the minutes of the August meeting something that is contrary to what is here. You haven't gotten those minutes until this morning and neither did the Commission. But going back to Section 9, the previous recommendation of the Commission considered at the August meeting was that the petitions be distributed so as to include not less than 5 per cent of the eligible voters voting for Governor in the last gubernatorial election in each of ten counties.
